Together with our partners, we are committed to protecting the environment from pollution caused by Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG). By working together we can help to protect public health, by keeping sewers unblocked. We will achieve this by raising awareness about the problem, passing on knowledge of good kitchen practice and disposal methods and celebrating the success and hard work of those who make a real commitment to preventing fats, oils and grease harming the environment.

FOG Charter

- We will seek to promote a scheme that gives recognition to those restaurants, takeaways and food producers in general who demonstrate concern for the environment and dispose of their fats, oils and grease responsibly.
- We will work with catering outlets to educate them about good kitchen practices to benefit them, their customers and the environment.
- We will advocate partnership schemes that promote free collection of fats, oils and grease for conversion into biodiesel or biofuel.
- We will promote methods to help dispose of fats, oils and grease such as traps and bio-remedial products as long as they are proved to be harmless to the environment.
- We will work with councils to help promote use of recycling centres for the collection of used cooking oil.
- We will raise awareness about the issue to our customers and the problems it causes and advise them how to dispose of fats, oils and grease.
- We will encourage staff on the ground to seek partnership working with environmental health officers in areas where fats, oils and grease in the sewer is a problem.
- We will seek to inform children and young people about the impact of fats in sewers to help educate future generations.
